MyDec at MyTax Illinois is used by individuals, title companies, and settlement agencies to submit, approve, or reject Real Property Transfer Tax Declarations (replaces the EZDec system). Participating counties now include Champaign, Cook, DuPage, Grundy, Jackson, Kane, Kankakee, Lake, LaSalle, Logan, Madison, Marion, McDonough, McLean, Ogle, Peoria, Rock Island, Sangamon, Tazewell, Whiteside, Winnebago, and Woodford, as well as the City of Chicago.
